Volunteer Opportunities at Alley Pond Environmental Center

At APEC, we do our best to find the best match for our volunteers to ensure a beneficial experience for the individual, the Center, and the visiting public. Volunteers will help the Center and their community while fostering their own environmental interests, knowledge, and personal growth. The addition of their talents and hours of service enables APEC to increase their services to the community and to enhance its operations.

APEC's goal is to encourage environmental awareness, appreciation, understanding, and responsibility through education. One of the most important ways we do this is through our volunteer program. The Center provides guidance, training, and supervision for volunteers, while our volunteers provide us with institutional support and program assistance. As a volunteer, you may be involved with:

Animal Care

Change water and freshen up cages. Exercise and groom animals. Feed animals.

Building Maintenance

Sweep and vacuum floors. Clean outside of glass animal tanks. Clean toys and tables in classrooms.

Special Events

Help greet and direct guests. Help staff tables and booths. Serve refreshments.

Arts & Crafts

Keep crafts for K-5 programs up to date. Create posters, games, and other materials to enhance programs and events.

Outdoor Opportunities

Maintain grounds and trails. Clean up outdoor picnic area. Maintain backyard area.

Clerical Work

Data entry, filing, proofreading, prepare envelopes for large mailings.

Guidelines and Timelines for our Youth Volunteer Program

APEC's Youth Volunteer Program is for high school students between ages 14 and 18 years old. To be considered for the Youth Volunteer Program, candidates must submit a completed application and participate in an interview. Once accepted, candidates will attend an orientation to familiarize themselves with APEC's facilities and their daily expectations. Acceptance emails post-interview will include orientation date(s).

The Youth Volunteer Program consists of 3 semesters: Fall, Spring, and Summer
